

Highlights from Northampton MUD Board Regular Meeting
1/7/2008

All directors were present. Additionally, Mr. Doug Eibsen of Peramco, Inc., and Jim Sheffield, the District's General Manager were present.

Jim Sheffield presented the General Manager's report. He informed us a large number of recreational fees for 2008 have been collected, including many new residents.

Over the holidays, both weight rooms were vandalized. Mr. Sheffield hopes to be able to identify the persons responsible.

Additionally, Mr. Sheffield informed us that some areas of the pathway along West Park may need to be replaced with concrete since the crushed granite is not holding up well in some areas. West Park Lake will also be stocked with catfish and bass. We hope to post the date and time so interested residents and their children can attend the release.

Mr. Eibsen discussed with us whether the M-102 Ditch project needs to be completed now. Since Harris County will not approve the streets in the subdivision until the drainage issues are resolved, the Board agreed that the issue concerning Harris County approval needs to be further investigated. Then a decision can be made as to whether the ditch improvement project can be delayed.

We adjourned at 8:00 pm.
