WHEREUPON, following a notation that notices of the meeting had been duly posted in accordance with law, copies of which are attached hereto as exhibits, the meeting was called to order.

PUBLIC COMMENTS

There were no comments from the public.

GENERAL MANAGER'S REPORT

Mr. Sheffield reported that 51 residents had renewed their recreation fee for 2014, stating that the usual bulk of renewals starts in the middle of January and continues through February. He also stated that additional renewals will be added as the swim season gears up. Mr. Sheffield then reported that the building usage continues to increase with only minor repairs necessary.

A discussion ensued among the Board regarding changing the recreation meetings to another time, perhaps late afternoon instead of night, in consideration of the consultants. There was much discussion regarding the pros and cons of this suggestion, but a decision was not made.

OPERATOR'S REPORT

Jim Sheffield presented information from Hays Utility South Corporation regarding two residences with rather high usage of potable water. There were no residents in attendance to present their position and possible cause of this high usage. A discussion ensued among the Board regarding how to manage issues of high usage in the future. The Board determined that the residents would be required to pay the North Harris County Regional Water Authority fees which are incurred. It was also determined that the Board would decide other fee issues on a case by case basis if brought before the Board.
